SYNOPSIS

The uniquely themed lands of *Magic Kingdom®* Park form the basis of this expedition of four distinctive eras of American history. This learning adventure guides students to discover the characteristics of rugged individualism, courage, optimism, tenacity and compassion that are at the heart of American culture.

In the patriotic and historical setting of *Liberty Square*®, two hundred years of history unfolds as students act as Historical Investigators interpreting records, artifacts, and illustrations to identify the era, issues, and American Spirit characteristics associated with their assignment. This idyllic backdrop provides a glimpse at five valiant American Presidents and events that resulted in the establishment of the United States of America, the writing of the constitution, and the creation of the office of president.

Frontierland® invites students to explore what drove Americans westward across prairies, mountains, and deserts without the comfort and safety of roads or settlements. An attraction experience highlights the impact of the American railroad on the western expansion.

This westward journey also draws awareness to the role of five spirited American women who overcame obstacles, stereotypes, social limitations, and danger to leave indelible imprints on the nation.

Back in *Liberty Square®*, *The Hall of Presidents®* attraction showcases the relationship between the beliefs and values of the Founding Fathers to the symbolism of the Office of the President of the United States.

Students reaffirm their commitment to the American Spirit through a symbolic ringing of the Liberty Bell and by placing their signature upon a reproduction of the Declaration of Independence.
